## **Evaluation: Face-to-face Regular Courses Level 5-9**

Assessment is continuous and will be done on a weekly basis based on:

- 1. Three mandatory online evaluation tasks (task 1, task 2, task 3)<sup>1</sup>
- 2. **Homework**: punctuality in returning your homework and its quality will count towards your final grade. It represents 9% of the final grade in your written assessment.
- 3. Attendance and active oral participation. It represents 9% of the final grade in your oral assessment.

These components will determine the WRITTEN and ORAL final grade in INSPIRA. There are no "final exams". To successfully pass the course students need a minimum passing score of 65 points out of 100 in both the written and the oral grades on Inspira. The grading points are as follows:

A Outstanding or Excellent= 95 points B Very good= 80 points C Pass= 65 points C- Fail= 60 points

Typically, tasks are scheduled on week 3, week 6 and week 9 (your teacher will let you know the exact dates). In case of conflict between your calendar and the scheduled time or deadline for a task, it is your responsibility to inform your teacher in writing in advance. Your teacher may then be able to offer you an alternative if possible. Missing one task or lacking oral performance might imply failing the course.

If you need to be absent from the class sessions for longer than three sessions due to health or work reasons, notify your teacher as this can have an impact on your evaluation. Spanish instructors present a variety of flexible solutions to support learners.
